

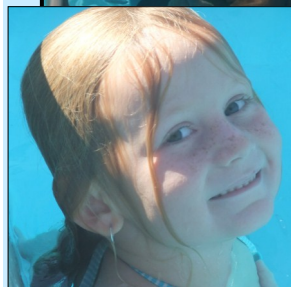

I have one brother, Ben, he is a Civil Engineer.

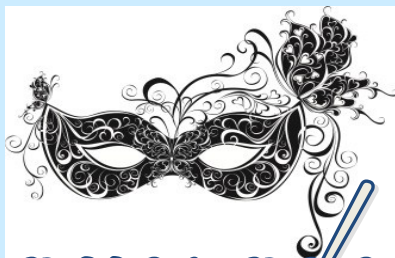
