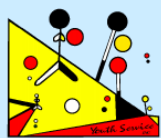

They then enjoyed a healthy morning tea and a play on all the wonderful new equipment at the preschool. Thank you to Sarah and Leanne for a wonderful visit.

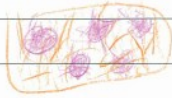

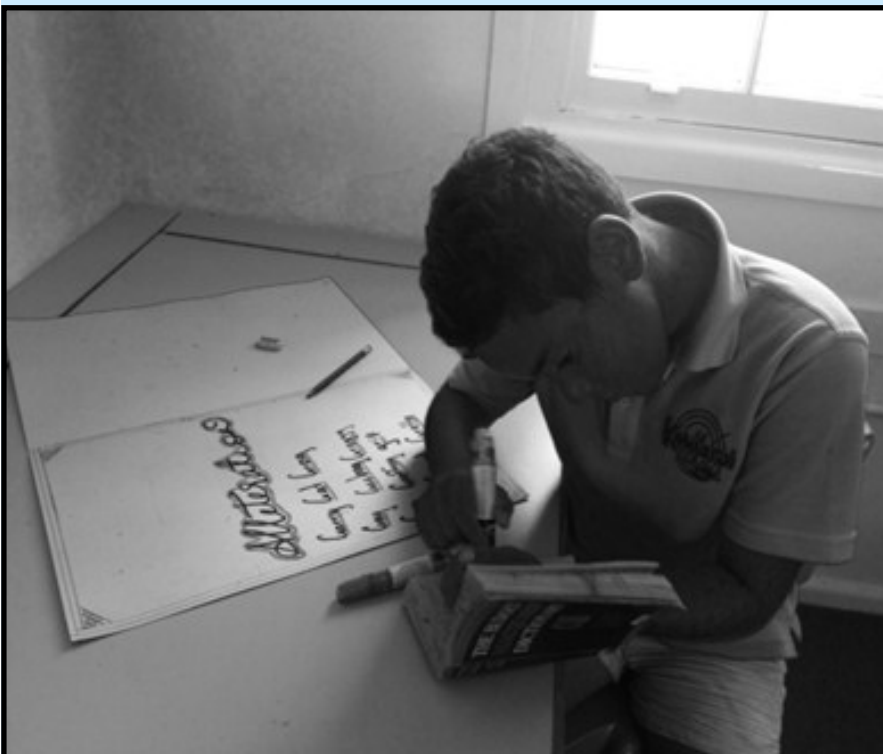
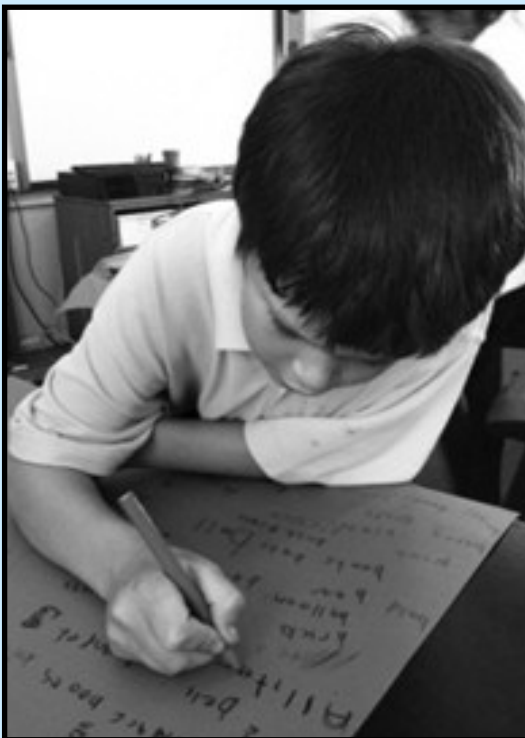

Helpful Hint No. 2

Using spell checker software.

A spell checker is an extra tool which does not replace the need to have a wide range of spelling knowledge and strategies. You can use a spell checker to assist you when writing and editing.

Errors which are not “fixed” or recognised by a spell checker:

Incorrect grammatical position

eg. *their/there*

Words not recognised by the computer, so no alternatives are given eg. *Parramatta*

Americanisations eg. *center*

Typographical errors (typos)

eg. *from/form*
