Darryl and Stephen trialed first in the Juniors; both boys completed the drill exercises with enthusiasm and confidence. In the trial game the boys played outstandingly, both boys scored a try, made line breaking runs and produced many try saving tackles. I would like to thank each student for their participation and the way they proudly represented their School, Families and Themselves. Congratulations to Darryl and Kydon who will now travel to play for the Moree Zone at the next stage against other Zone Teams across the North West Region. I encourage all students to participate in all opportunities and hopefully next year we will be taking a bus not a car to the Trials.



Word webs


Word webs can be constructed, to build up lists of words based on a particular skill or knowledge to be learned. The webs can be added to over days or weeks, as additional examples come to mind.
